

# **How to Prepare Your Property for Portable Toilets**

Whether you are hosting a backyard party, a wedding, a corporate event, or a construction project, a little site preparation can make your portable restroom rental safer and more convenient for everyone.

#### 1. Choose a Safe, Level Area

- Look for firm ground such as pavement, gravel, or well-compacted soil.
- Avoid low spots where water collects during rain.
- Ensure enough space around units for doors to open fully and people to queue.

#### 2. Plan for Access and Visibility

- Place restrooms close enough to be convenient, but not the center of attention in photos.
- Avoid steep slopes, tight corners, or narrow gates that make delivery difficult.
- Consider simple signs to help people find the restrooms, especially at large events.

## 3. Think About Lighting and Safety

- Add temporary lighting or solar stake lights along paths for evening events.
- Keep walkways free of cords, hoses, or tripping hazards.
- If children will be present, choose locations that are visible but still offer privacy.

## 4. For Restroom Trailers

- Confirm driveway and gate width for truck and trailer access.
- Choose a location where the trailer can be leveled and safely parked.
- Leave room for ramps, steps, and a small queue in front of the doors.

#### 5. Coordinate With Your Venue or Neighbors

- If you are hosting an event at home, let neighbors know about delivery and pickup times.
- At rented venues, check where the venue allows or prefers restrooms to be placed.
- Confirm any local rules about placement near sidewalks or public roads.
